Camp By-Law Changes

Pursuant to the continuing effort to secure a group exemption status under the Internal Revenue Service 501c3 regulations and at the request of the Sons of Union Veterans of the Civil War (SUVCW) National Treasurer, specific language shall be inserted into, if not already appearing, in the by-laws of each Department and Camp of the SUVCW.

This action is required to become a 501c3 throughout the SUVCW organization. Currently only the National is a 501c3 which allows donations to be tax deductible and certain expenses of accomplishing work within the organization to be tax deductible. Most of the Camps and Departments are currently 501c4. This means no tax deductions are allowed for donations.

All camps in the Department of Indiana should amend their by-laws and submit them to the department for review and final approval no later than March 1, 2019. I strongly encourage all camps to start working on your by-laws now and submit your amended by-laws well before the deadline.
